One-Way Conversion with Contraflow Bike Lane Todd Pl NE Traffic Direction Change from Eastbound to Westbound

The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) received a Traffic Safety Assessment (TSA) request in September 2019 from ANC Commissioner Sylvia Pinkney (5E04), requesting for a permanent one-way conversion on T St NE. In November 2019, Langley Elementary School also fully supported this TSA. In February 2020, DDOT shared the study results with the ANC and the school, recommending the permanent one-way conversion. During the public health emergency, DDOT has further reviewed and has come up with additional improvements, which can be found below.

Planned Changes

- Permanent one way eastbound on T St NE between Lincoln and 2nd St NE
 Note: currently one-way between Lincoln Rd and Summit PI during school hours only
- 2. Contraflow bike lane along T St in addition to the one-way conversation Note: there will be no parking impact as there will be parking lanes on both sides
- **3**. Todd PI NE one-way westbound **Note:** currently one-way eastbound
